I did make sure that I implement my lesson and let them sing the songs in a good environment that they can be comfortable in it. "providing kids with the combination of a safe environment and activates they love, will allow them to gradually come out of their shells (parenting & Education in Ireland, n.d.).

When I finished from explaining the activity for them I asked them a few questions about the subtraction and then I asked them either they stay in the class or go outside in the garden to do the activity some of them choose in the class and some of them choose the garden, because children learn fast and engage faster in the natural environment than in the class which also they can play and learn "play is the highest expression of human development in childhood for it alone is the free expression of what is in the child's soul." (Froebel, n.d.),
