Make sure that I am using voice tone.	
Lesson Focus Review the five letters for the students A, S, C, P, T.	
Lesson Outcomes At the end of the lesson, students will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- List words that start with the letters 'A, S, C, P, T.'- Distinguish and employ the reviewed letters.- Recognize the words that start with the five reviewed letters.	
Links to Prior Learning I will review the letters they learned last week, which are 'A,' 'S,' 'C,' 'P,' 'T,', remind them of the words that start with the letter.	
21st Century Skills - Literacy skills (ICT – media – technology): It is an online session, I will use a laptop, and the students will use a laptop or a tablet to enter the session. For the session, I will use PowerPoint slides, play video songs, and play online games with the students for the activities time.	

- Learning skills (critical thinking – effective communication): Ask the students questions during the lesson, communicate, share, and discuss.

The teacher will ask the students: - What letter does it start with? - Can you tell me something that starts with these letters?

Possible problems for learners

Pronounce the words.

Maybe the low ability will not follow the lesson with me.

The students might face difficulty in knowing what the picture represents or what it is called. If the songs did not work and I did not play it, the students might not feel engaged and start to misbehave.

Solutions to possible problems

Repeat the word for them let them say it more than one time and explain for them more.

I will try to give them the lesson in easy way also I will encloud to my lesson a picture where it will help them engage with me.

I will tell the students what the pictures are called, as well as read the names written on the screen for the students who are facing any difficulty. I will sing the song on my own, or I will use YouTube to open the song and play it (I will keep the tabs open and ready before the lesson, in case).

The students in this group will solve the choosing right answer activity they will see the picture and decide what letter this picture start with.

The students in this group will solve the arrange the words activity where they have to arrange the letters correctly.

Differentiation activities (Stretch)

For the students who have done from the activity which they are group 3 I will let them to write for me one word that starts with each letter from the reviewed letters and them I will ask them to write one sentence for each word.
